Duties of the Graveyard Board

- To oversee the maintenance of the Church graveyard and ensure its conformity to Moravian traditions and its continuing availability for future Church generations.
- To assist funeral directors or other responsible persons in locating or opening an appropriate grave site and to ensure that the grave site is closed appropriately.
- To assist family members in selecting and placing appropriate markers or grave stones.
- To determine eligibility for interment in the Church graveyard and to establish fees for non-members or others not eligible for interment without charge.
- To receive payment, where appropriate, for grave sites used or where use is anticipated.
- To maintain records of all grave sites in use and of all pre-payments received from non-members or others not eligible for interment without charge.
- To hire a contractor to maintain the Church graveyard or in other ways ensure the graveyard is maintained appropriately.
- To plan for graveyard expansion where necessary, working with the Joint Board concerning the use of Church property.
- To perform an annual audit of Graveyard Fund finances. This audit may be performed independently or in conjunction with the audit of Church finances.

Duties of the Board of Elders

- To watch over and be responsible for the spiritual and moral well-being of the congregation.
- To assist the Pastor in visitation of the sick and elderly and others who may need spiritual encouragement.
- To maintain proper Church discipline.
- To regulate the various meetings of worship.
- To determine for what use and purpose the Church facilities can be used.
- To pass upon all names of persons presenting themselves for membership, the names of members to be transferred to other churches, also the names of members to be suspended, dropped, or excluded.
- To administer the program of Christian Education through our Christian Education Committee.
- To make annual appointment of non-salaried personnel, such as but not exclusive to, musicians, sextons, ushers, dieners, and others engaged in the service of the church.
- To assist the Pastor in the administration of church music.

Duties of the Board of Trustees

- To oversee the temporal and material affairs of the congregation.
- To determine the best method of meeting the budget.
- To maintain the property of the congregation.
- To appoint the Church Treasurer and other chairpersons and committees that pertains to the temporal affairs of the church, such as building and grounds.
- To have the congregation's finances audited as required.
- To make prompt and complete settlement of all accounts with the Provincial treasurer.
- To assist and require the treasurer of the congregation to make available to the congregation a copy of the financial report each month, and to give a financial report of the preceding year to the Church Council meeting each year.
- To administer the financial programs of the congregation
